DIRECTIONS TO TRIAL SITE

From I-4: Take Exit 27, the Polk Parkway (this is West of Lakeland). Get off at Exit # 3, pay \$.25 toll, turn right on Airport Road. Go 1/2 mile to Drane Field Road, turn left, go 1/2 mile to Century Blvd. across from the airport, turn left. Go to the fourth driveway and turn left into the warehouse complex. Drive between the buildings and go to the building in the back. Come in the door in the middle of the building. There is plenty of parking but please be considerate of other businesses' parking areas (that is, right in front of another open business -- not too critical on Sundays but many DO work on Saturdays).

From Hwy 60 (from Brandon): Take County Line Road north to Drane Field Road. Go east 2 to 3 miles to Century Blvd across from the airport, turn left. Go to the fourth driveway and turn left into the warehouse complex. Drive between the buildings and go to the building in the back. Come in the door in the middle of the building. There is plenty of parking but please be considerate of other businesses' parking areas (that is, right in front of another open business -- not too critical on Sundays but many DO work on Saturdays).

From US 98 (from Bartow): Go north on US 98 to the Polk Parkway, take the ramp West (Tampa). Get off the Parkway at Waring Road exit, follow the frontage road to the light (Waring Road), turn left, go through the light under the Parkway and go to the light at Drane Field Road. Turn right, go 1/2 mile to Century Blvd across from the airport, turn right. Go to the fourth driveway and turn left into the warehouse complex. Drive between the buildings and go to the building in the back. Come in the door in the middle of the building. There is plenty of parking but please be considerate of other businesses' parking areas (that is, right in front of another open business -- not too critical on Sundays but many DO work on Saturdays).

NOTICE TO EXHIBITORS

ENTRIES

- **Obedience Entry Fees Each Day:** \$25.00 for first entry of each dog in a regular class or optional titling class, including AKC recording fee. \$15.00 for entry of each dog in a non-regular class or additional entry of a dog that is already entered in a regular or optional titling class.
- **Rally Entry Fees Each Day:** \$25.00 as first entry and \$15.00 as additional entry of the same dog, including AKC recording fee.
- Entries will not be accepted unless on a signed official AKC entry form. All fees must be enclosed. **No entry will be accepted, canceled or changed after the closing date. Telephone and faxed entries cannot be accepted.**
- Checks should be made payable to “DTCT” (Returned Checks will be assessed a \$20.00 fee.)

- Per AKC, “A recording fee of \$3.50 will be required for each dog entered. If a dog is entered in more than one class, the recording fee will be collected on the first entry only.” The recording fee is included in the trial entry fee.
- If, because of riots, civil disturbances, or other acts beyond the control of the Trial Committee, it is impossible to open or complete the Trial, no refund of entry will be made.
- **Transfers (moveups):** Transfers for the Saturday, October 27 trials must be submitted to the Trial Secretary by Monday, October 22. Transfers for the Sunday, October 28 trials must be submitted to the Trial Secretary by the close of Saturday’s trials. Contact or see the Trial Secretary for transfer forms.

TRIAL SITE

- Overnight parking at the trial site is NOT allowed. **There is no space for RVs.**
- The building will be air conditioned for the dogs’ comfort.

OTHER

- Food and drinks will **not** be available for sale on the premises. However, there are a number of fast food restaurants closeby.
- Dogs should be present at least ½ hour prior to judging and will be excused immediately after the class unless needed for further judging.
- Due to space constraints, unentered dogs and X-pens are not allowed on the premises during the Trials.
- Obedience jump heights will be 8” – 36” on Saturday and 36” – 8” on Sunday.

CLASS PRIZES

Ribbons and tug toys handmade by The Tug Team, 1st through 4th place, will be awarded in all classes. Prizes will be awarded in the ring by the Judge at the end of the class. Green qualifying ribbons will be presented to all who qualify in the regular classes. Rosettes and a certificate for one free entry in a future DTCT trial will be awarded for obedience High in Trial, obedience High Combined score in Open and Utility, rally High Combined score in Rally Advanced and Rally Excellent, and rally High Combined Triple score in Rally Advanced, Rally Excellent and Rally Master.

HOW TO USE THE ENTRY BLANK

Use one entry blank per dog only if all information is EXACTLY THE SAME FOR each day. Carefully check the blocks for each DAY, AND TRIAL in which you wish to enter your dog. You MUST use a SEPARATE entry blank for each trial if you are entering your dog in a different class at a different trial. (Obedience and Rally entries may be on the same entry form IF they are for the same dog in the same classes.) A separate entry form is required for each dog entered in the brace class, if offered. Exhibitors see “Entry Fees” each trial in Notice to Exhibitors section of Premium list: Obedience and Rally are separate trials and each first entry is \$25.00. Do not forget to sign the Agreement on the back of the entry form.

ENTRY BLANK INSTRUCTIONS FROM AKC

1. A dog must be entered in the name of the person who actually owned it at the time entries for an event closed. If a registered dog has been acquired by a new owner it must be entered in the name of its new owner in any event for which entries closed after the date of acquirement, regardless of whether the new owner has received the registration certificate indicating that the dog is recorded in his/her name. State on entry form whether transfer application has been mailed to the AKC. (For complete rules, refer to Chapter 11, Section 3.)
2. Dogs listed in the **AKC Canine Partners SM Program** may be eligible to enter all-breed AKC Obedience trials at the club's option. These dogs should be listed as All American Dog and must include their AKC Number on the entry form and check the AKC No. box. Sire and Dam information shall remain blank for mixed breed entrants.

RALLY EXHIBITORS PLEASE NOTE

- If your Rally class requires a jump height (because the class will be ordered by jump height) you **MUST** supply a jump height on your entry form or the trial secretary will not accept your entry. The Trial Secretary will not contact you for this information.

<u>Height of Dog at Withers</u>	<u>Jump Height</u>
Less than 10 inches	4 inches
10 inches to less than 15 inches	8 inches
15 inches to less than 20 inches	12 inches
<u>20 inches and over</u>	16 inches

- Rally jump heights for Saturday will be 16"- 4", and Sunday, 4"- 16".
- Rally transfers from Rally Novice to Rally Intermediate require a jump height on the transfer form.
- **You are expected to understand the Rally Rules and understand which Rally class "A" or "B" at any level to enter. The rules differ between the Rally Novice class, Intermediate and Advanced/Excellent and Master classes. Be advised that your leg will not count if you earn it in the wrong class! Consult the AKC rules for Rally at www.akc.org.**

In consideration of the acceptance of this entry, I (we) agree to abide by the rules and regulations of The American Kennel Club in effect at the time of this event, and any additional rules and regulations appearing in the premium list of this event and entry form and any decision made in accord with them. I (we) agree that the club holding this event has the right to refuse this entry for cause which the club shall deem sufficient. I (we) certify and represent that the dog entered is not a hazard to persons or other dogs. In consideration of the acceptance of this entry and of the holding of this event and of the opportunity to have the dog judged and to win prizes, ribbons, or trophies, I (we) agree to hold the AKC, the event-giving club, their members, directors, governors, officers, agents, superintendents or event secretary and the owner and/or lessor of the premises and any provider of services that are necessary to hold this event and any employees or volunteers of the aforementioned parties, and any AKC approved judge, judging at this event, harmless from any claim for loss or injury which may be alleged to have been caused directly or indirectly to any person or thing by the act of this dog while in or about the event premises or grounds or near any entrance thereto, and I (we) personally assume all responsibility and liability for any such claim; and I (we) further agree to hold the aforementioned parties harmless from any claim for loss, injury or damage to this dog.
